Phieffer, THAT the Belleville Public Library Board approves the accession of the newly acquired Manly MacDonald oil painting, "Log House", purchased at auction, into the Parrott Gallery permanent collection, and THAT the Board authorizes the transfer of \$4,348 from the Parrott Deferred Revenue account to the 2022 operating budget to fund the purchase, and THAT the Belleville Public Library Board approves the accession of the donated Manly MacDonald oil painting, "Portrait of Mrs. Ronald Catto", into the Parrott Gallery permanent collection. **CARRIED**
