Mohawk artist and designer Narda Julg will show examples of her creations that have been featured across North America.

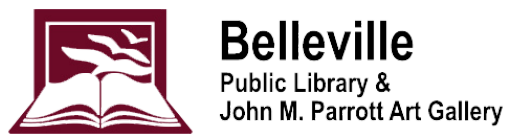

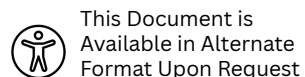
